At this year's Satellite Symposium we will explore the following questions using the GARFIELD-AF dataset:

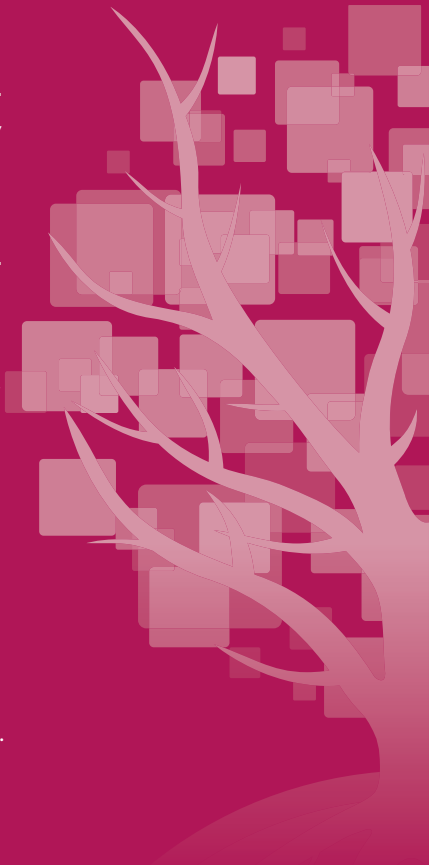
- What is the burden of AF?
